

LAUNDRY TIPS

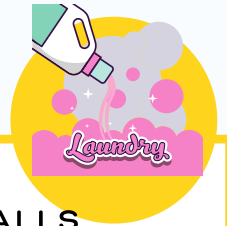
You can't afford to live without!



DONT LET LAUNDRY BUILD UP

Letting laundry build up means some stains may set. This leads to having a wide variety of available clothes you can't wear in public!

Try to do one to two loads a day, making sure to check pockets and glance over clothing for any stains.



USE WOOL DRYER BALLS

This will save you a ton of money on fabric softener.

Just toss a ball in your dryer with each load and that's it!

FOLD CLOTHES RIGHT AWAY

As soon as the clothes are finished in the dryer, fold them ASAP. This eliminates breaking out the dreaded iron.

If that is not possible, I use Downy Wrinkle Releaser. Just spray on your item and tug the wrinkles away.



TREAT STAINS ASAP

ASK FOR HELP

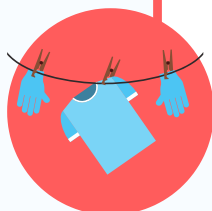
As soon as you feel like your kiddos are old enough, teach them how to sort, wash and dry some of their own clothes.

LAUNDRY STAIN TIPS

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BLOOD

Rinse stain with:

Hydrogen Peroxide
Dawn Dishwashing Soap

Then I soak in water with some additional Oxiclean granules mixed in. for several hours



OIL/GREASE

Spray some WD-40 on the stain, then scrub with Dawn Dishwashing detergent

TOMATO BASED STAINS



Flush first with cool water, then use White Vinegar. If all else fails you can use a red wine stain remover for all of these stains

GRASS STAINS

Rubbing alcohol works great on these stains!



LIPSTICK

This is an oily stain. Try working in some:
Vegetable oil or WD-40.

Add some ammonia

Finish with Dawn Dishwashing liquid



PEN

Try using some hairspray or rubbing alcohol
